


- **WHAT:** 4 mini grants (\$125 each)
- Water conservation efforts that are visible to neighbors (front, side of property) – identified by weather proof signs
- May be any size in terms of overall budget, our stipends will cover \$125 of expenses
- **GOAL:** Inspire more Cherryhill neighbors to adopt similar measures in the coming year!

- **MINI GRANT WINNERS:** A willingness to display an acrylic lawn sign until June 2016 as well as field questions from interested neighbors (as needed)
